This letter is to inform you of the wage and fringe benefit rate changes per the Collective Bargaining Agreements negotiated by the Chicago Regional Council of Carpenters and the Residential Construction Employers Council (RCEC) in full force and effect from October 1st, 2014 through September 30th, 2019. The following schedules summarize the changes for Wages and Benefits effective October 1st, 2017 through September 30th, 2018. All contribution amounts not listed below remain unchanged.

- 1<sup>st</sup> year 40% of Journeyman's wages
- 2<sup>nd</sup> year 50% of Journeyman's wages
- 3<sup>rd</sup> year 65% of Journeyman's wages
- 4<sup>th</sup> year 80% of Journeyman's wages
